This sport is a very popular team sport played by 2 teams of 11 players. It is a very popular sport and famous players are paid millions of dollars. It is played with an oval ball with pointed ends. The players wear protective equipments: a helmet, shoulder pads and a mouth guard because it is a dangerous contact sport. In this sport, you have to gain territory and score points.

This sport is very popular in England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and Ireland. There are 2 teams of 22 players each. You play with a bat and a ball. One team bats and the other catches the ball. A game can be very long: sometimes 4 or 5 days! All the players have white T shirts, white pullovers and white trousers. Indian people also practise this sport.

This is a ball sport played by 2 teams of 7 players. Games are played on a rectangular court. Players throw the ball into a ring attached to a long post. This sport is similar to basketball and is mainly played by women: it is the most popular women's sport in Australia.

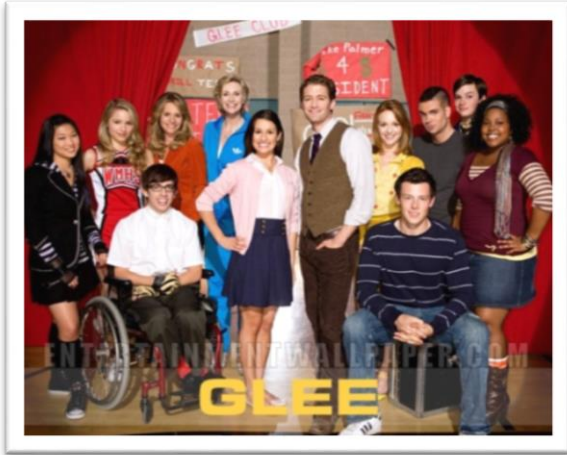

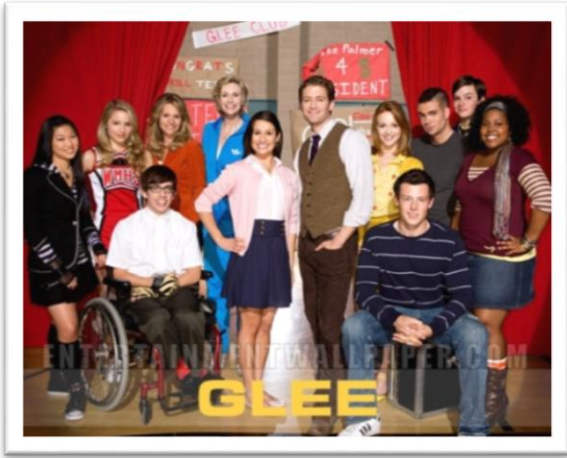
