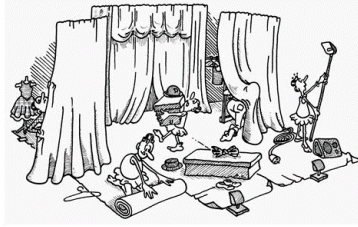


## EXERCISES IN ENGLISH



### Do what I say :

Jump/ Run/ Walk/ Stop

### Walk :

Hands up/ on tiptoe/ as Penguins/as an old person

### The statue :

When I clap, walk the other way round or stop walking

Walk with a friend

### Make a line :

Alphabet of your first names

Colour of your clothes

### Emotions :

Walk in the room and express the feeling the teacher says

4 pupils sit on a chair and say the same sentence with a different emotion

### Voice :

Say a sentence to someone facing you

being further and further from the person

### Imposer des mots et jouer la scène :

Choose four students to be Storytellers, and one Pointer.

The Pointer picks one person to start the story, and then randomly switches between people.

The goal is to continue telling a cohesive story, picking up where the last person left off.

A participant "dies" if they make a continuity error (accidentally change the setting, for example) or if they hesitate too long before picking up the thread of the story. The audience can be the judge, and participants can "die" an exaggerated stage death for more fun. Last person standing wins.
