Mom is very happy with her horrible tyrannosaurus, Skippy, and Jessica's got a terrific black motorbike.



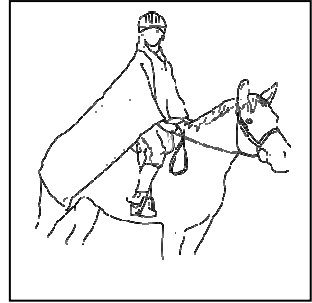
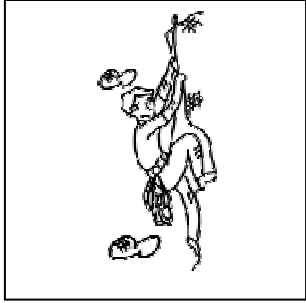
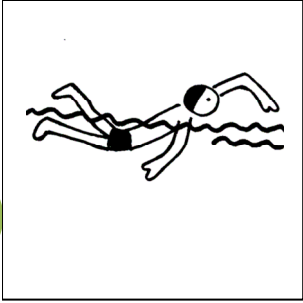
