

He created Sherlock Holmes.



Where did he live?




Where did he live?

ELEMENTARY, MY DEAR.....




Who did he live with?





How long ago was he born?




He was born 158 years ago.

Sir Arthur Conan Doyle wrote his first Sherlock Holmes book in 1887. How long ago?



He wrote it 130 years ago!

In 1893, in the novel <u>The</u> <u>Final Problem</u>, Holmes and his enemy Moriarty, died together in a waterfall.



But readers protested!

So Doyle brought Holmes back to life in 1901 in the very famous novel: The Hound of the Baskervilles.



It was 116 years ago!

Doyle died in 1930.
